The City of Conway is requesting permission to enter into reimbursement agreement with Exxon Mobil Pipeline associated with the Arterial Loop Project. The South Interchange phase of the Western Loop crosses the 20" ExxonMobil petroleum pipeline about 1,100 feet west of the UP Railroad and immediately behind the Gold Creek Baptist Church. This crossing is on the City portion of the Phase I – South Loop Project.

As part of the Utility Adjustment requirements to allow the new roadway to cross their existing pipeline & easement, ExxonMobil is requiring that the coating on the existing pipe line be replaced. This requires that the existing pipeline be dug up and exposed, sand blasted and recoated. Their estimated cost to perform this work is \$275,369.23.

This amount has been previously provided and is included in the utility adjustment item of Garver's project cost estimate. The cost may be reimbursable out of the state contribution to the project if sufficient funds are available.

This work needs must be completed prior to the AHTD allowing the contract for the road construction to proceed (spring 2013). We are at a point now that this should move forward to avoid delaying the project.

REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement made and entered into this _____ day of ______, 2012, by and between Mobil Pipe Line Company ("MPL") having a mailing address at P.O. Box 2220, Houston, Texas 77252-2220, and the City of Conway, Arkansas ("THE CITY"), whose mailing address is 1201 Oak St., Conway, Arkansas 72032:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, MPL owns and operates a 20" pipeline, said pipeline being a part of a pipeline system known as the Corsicana-Patoka line; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY has developed plans to construct a portion of the Conway Arterial Loop and Sidebottom Road which will require the adjustment of the MPL pipeline to accommodate these roads; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY has requested that MPL adjust and/or take protective action on a portion of the aforementioned pipeline, and

WHEREAS, THE CITY has agreed to reimburse MPL for the actual costs and expenses incurred in the adjustment of said pipeline;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, it is hereby agreed by and between THE CITY and MPL as follows:

ADJUSTMENT OF PIPELINES: MPL shall recondition the pipeline as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and becoming a part hereof. The work on the pipeline shall be done by MPL and/or its contractors in a workmanlike and expeditious manner in accordance with accepted industry practices and work schedules, and using diligence to complete said adjustment.

<u>PAYMENT BY THE CITY</u>: THE CITY shall pay in advance to MPL the estimated cost for the adjustment of said pipeline. A copy of said estimate is attached hereto in Exhibit "A". Should the <u>actual cost</u> be less than the <u>estimated cost</u>, the difference shall be refunded to THE CITY upon project completion and reconciliation. Should the <u>actual cost</u> be greater than the <u>estimated cost</u>, THE CITY shall remit the difference to MPL within ninety (90) days of the presentation of a statement showing actual costs and support materials.

INGRESS AND EGRESS: THE CITY hereby grants to MPL the right of ingress and egress across all lands owned, leased or controlled by THE CITY as may be reasonable or necessary for MPL to adjust, inspect, cover, test, connect, operate and maintain the adjusted pipeline. Such ingress and egress shall be along routes as agreed by MPL and THE CITY.

AUDIT: THE CITY shall have the right at any time to audit and obtain copies of the books, records and accounts of MPL relating to the invoice presented for payment at the completion of the work on this project.

ENTIRETY OF AGREEMENT: This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto and no alterations of the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by both of the parties hereto. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors or assigns.

This project involves the construction of 2,665 feet of 12' wide asphalt pathway from Mimosa Drive to Dave Ward Drive along Stone Dam Creek; the construction of a 120 foot span pedestrian bridge across Stone Dam Creek; and the construction of a 32 space parking lot near the end of Mimosa Drive. The four bids received for this project are listed below and detailed on the enclosed bid tabulation.

This project was not awarded at the time bids were received due to issues with easements. We are now securing the remaining easements thru the platting process and will have all the necessary easements.

The low bidder, F.P. Bivens, is OK with proceeding with the project as bid in 2011 with the exception of the decorative fence bid item. The fence subcontractor will not hold his price on this item. The price of the fence looks to high anyway (\$75.00 per foot for 800 feet of fence = \$60,000). We could remove the fence from the contract by Change Order and secure a separate contract for a less expensive style fence (usually about \$30.00 per foot). I have recommend award of this project to the low bidder F. P. Bivens Construction, Inc. with a Change Order eliminating the decorative fence for a net amount of \$709,239.35.

The funding for this project would utilize the Parks & Recreation Bond's reserved for Pedestrian Trails.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Conway committed to transfer \$2,000,000 in Sanitation Enterprise Fund monies to the General Fund with the successful passage of the rededication of the 2006 quarter cent sales tax as discussed in Resolution R-11-73; and

WHEREAS, These monies were initially budgeted in Sanitation for capital equipment purchases, and have since been transferred to the line item Transfers to Other Funds, since bond proceeds will be used to purchase the capital equipment; and

WHEREAS, The General Fund budget needs to be amended to show the inflow from the Sanitation Enterprise Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1: The City of Conway shall increase the budget for account number 001-119-4800 Transfers from Other Funds by \$2,000,000.

Section 2: All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

City of Conway, Arkansas Ordinance No. O-12-___

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR A GENERAL FUND RESERVE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Conway committed to create and fund a true General Fund Reserve of \$2,000,000 with the successful passage of the rededication of the 2006 quarter cent sales tax as discussed in Resolution R-11-73; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of R-11-73 says that the Reserve will be funded over a period of four years (2012 – 2015) by dedicating \$500,000 each year into the Reserve as monies come available on a cash flow basis; and

WHEREAS, Funding the 2012 portion of the Reserve was not part of the adopted 2012 Budget for the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1: The City of Conway shall appropriate \$500,000 of General Fund money to satisfy the Reserve funding for 2012.

Section 2: All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.
