Alderwoman Smith motioned to approve the Dec. 11, 2007 minutes as submitted. Alderman Bell seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0.

Alderman Bell motioned to adopt the resolution. Alderwoman Smith seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed 8-0. The public hearing is set for Tuesday Jan. 8, 2008 at 6:30 pm.

2. Ordinance appropriating funds for the Planning department salary adjustments and capital improvements.

Mayor Townsell explained this will allow us to increase personnel, renovate the department, and adjust the pay grid to compensate employees at a more comparable market rate. Alderman Bell motioned to waive the readings of the ordinance. Alderman Hawkins seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0. Alderman Bell motioned to adopt the ordinance. Alderwoman Whitmore seconded the motion. There was no discussion. 3. Ordinance amending section 11.04.02 of the Conway Municipal code in regards to new building permits for the City of Conway.

Ben Wiedower, City Inspector, stated sometime after Jan. 1, 2008 the state of Arkansas will adopt the 2008 National Fire Prevention Assn. code and this will require all receptacles in a home, other than special use receptacles, to be arc fault protected. Mr. Wiedower briefly explained the changes for mom-metallic sheathed cable, aluminum wire, and permitting of alternative power sources. Alderwoman Smith motioned to waive the readings of the ordinance. Alderman Bell seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed 8-0. Alderwoman Smith motioned to adopt the ordinance. Alderman Bell seconded the motion. The clerk called the roll with the following voting "Aye": Alderman Hawkins, Alderman Grimes, Alderman Vaught, Alderwoman Smith, Alderman Bell, Alderman Jones, Alderwoman Whitmore, and Alderwoman Mehl. The motion passed 8-0.

Alderwoman Smith motioned to accept the bids. Alderman Bell seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed 8-0.

Alderwoman Smith motioned to suspend the rules and move item B-8 "Consideration of an amended agreement for property located on East Siebenmorgan Road" up on the agenda. Alderman Bell seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0.

Mayor Townsell explained that there was a lien on this property, owned by Tim Freyaldenhoven, which has taken six months to clear the deed and all the dates in the previous agreement have since passed. Mr. Freyaldenhoven is requesting six months which will allow him time to find land and move the house. Mayor Townsell stated he was concerned because we planned on bidding the new boy's softball complex out in late April 2008; looking to start construction in May 2008. Mayor Townsell feels we should honor the original time frame of six months and suggested we add a bonus of \$5,000 if Mr. Freyaldenhoven can get the house moved by May 1, 2008. Alderman Hawkins motioned to accept the amended "offer and acceptance". Alderwoman Whitmore seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed 8-0.

B. Public Service Committee (Sanitation, Parks & Recreation, & Physical Plant)

1. Consideration of accepting annual bids for 6 yard front load containers, 96 gallon (green) refuse roll carts, and 64 gallon (blue) refuse roll carts.

Cheryl Harrington, Sanitation Director, recommended accepting the low bid on the 6 yard front load containers from Roll-Off's of America for 617.00 each.

Ms. Harrington recommended accepting the low bid on the 96 gallon refuse roll carts from Toter Inc., the second lowest bidder, for \$18,291.42; the low bidder did not meet bid specs.

Ms. Harrington recommended accepting the low bid on the 64 gallon refuse roll carts from Toter Inc. for \$21,600.08.

Alderman Bell motioned to accept the 3 bids recommended by Ms. Harrington. Alderwoman Smith seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The motion passed 8-0.

2. Ordinance appropriating revenue funds to the Conway Sanitation Department for a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility.

Cheryl Harrington, Sanitation Director, stated they will be building a new Household Hazardous Waste Collection facility center and these funds have been collected over the past several years from an E-Waste account; in addition to \$10,000 donated by the Faulkner County Quorum Court to help defray a portion of the cost of the facility, and help the citizens of This facility will allow residents to dispose of Faulkner Co. electronics/hazardous waste. We hope to turn around and give these items back to the public who are in need; we do not want to put these items in our landfill. Alderwoman Smith motioned to waive the readings of the ordinance. Alderman Bell seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0. There was no further discussion. Alderman Bell motioned to adopt the ordinance. Alderwoman Smith seconded the motion.
