# AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE ALL BUT THE NORTH 15' FEET OF THE NORTH 45 FEET ACCESS AND UTILITY EASEMENT AS SHOWN ON THE FINAL PLAT OF LOT 4, LOCATED IN THE MEADOWS COMMERCIAL SUBDIVISION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES;

WHEREAS, a petition was duly filed with the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2008 asking the City Council to reduce a portion of the 45.0' utility/access easement as shown on a final plat of Lot 4, Meadows Commercial Subdivision.
