2010 projects:

- Connect the Tucker Creek Trail to the new section currently under construction.
- Complete Tyler-Siebenmorgen. Sharrows/signs,
- Build bike trail (sidepath) on western side of S. Donaghey from University Apts. To Dave Ward.

2009 projects include:

- Striping Tyler, S. German, Farve, S. Salem, Hogan
- Tucker Creek trail extension, striping Hogan.
- Add bike lanes on Caldwell,

Finley Vanson is the city traffic engineer.

Mention was made of an ordinance for bike parking requirements for new buildings. Was this part of BFC resolution? It is not clear where this came from.

The group wants to revisit "bike boulevards and signed bike routes.

According to the police chief the legality of bikes on sidewalks is ambiguous. He's going to double-check on it.

Ronnie Hall indicated that the problems on S. Salem bike lanes are due to bad gravel. The need for routine maintenance was discussed.
