Whereas, graffiti and vandalism have been significant and continuing problems with public artwork in the city; and

Whereas, the City of Conway has numerous public mural installations that have been commissioned; and

Whereas, the City of Conway Public Art Committee has expressed interest in ensuring that publicly owned art installations are properly protected from any damage that may occur.

Mural Protection Proposal

The Problem

Murals in the Underground Art Walk are being defaced with spray paint and no clearly established maintenance plan for their ongoing protection. This reflects poorly on the City of Conway, erodes artist trust in the Public Art Board that work created for the city will receive proper care, and is harmful to public perception of art.

The Proposed Solution

It is hereby proposed that the Public Art Board, with the financial sign-off from the City Council, purchase a commercially available protective coating for the murals which will allow any defacement to be removed without damaging the artwork underneath.

Upon recommendations from the Public Art Network of Americans for the Arts, the best solution with themost positive results is a product called Mural Shield paired with a top coat of World's Best Graffiti Coating (both products sold from the same manufacturer).

According to the manufacturer website, the coating needed for approximately 10' x 100' is:

MuralShield Square Ft Coverage (Sq Ft): 250

World's Best Graffiti Coating Square Ft Coverage (Sq Ft): 350

MuralShield (gal): 4 | WB Graffiti Coating (gal): 3

As each product is available in 5-gallon drums the cheapest option is to purchase one of each, which also incurs a hazmat charge for shipping:

MuralShield - \$495.00 x 5 gallons World's Best Graffiti Coating - \$650.00 x 10 Gallons Hazmat fee: \$117.00Pretax total -\$1,262

Conclusion

So for approximately \$1500 (to cover shipping and application costs) the Board could have a solution to vandalism in the Art Walk and test a future solution to mural defacement.

Funds could be crowdsourced with the cooperation of CAFTA and other arts organizations to go back into the PAC budget. Application of the coatings will be handled by the capable City of Conway Physical Plant.

City of Conway, Arkansas Ordinance No. <u>O-21-</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EXISTING RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON CITY BICYCLE LANES AND PEDESTRIAN PATHWAYS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; REPEALING OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Conway has established designated bicycle lanes and pedestrian pathways for the use and enjoyment of its citizens, Ordinance 0-98-95; and

WHEREAS, these pathways should be free of motorized vehicles subject to the exceptions set out herein; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend the current restrictions to increase the safety of bicyclists and pedestrians, and to clarify to operators of motorized vehicles the restrictions and exceptions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. The current restrictions, set forth in Chapter 8.56 – Bicycle and Pedestrian Pathways, is amended as follows:

8.56.01 - Definitions.

Bicycle means a human-powered vehicle with two (2) or more wheels in tandem, designed to transport by the act of pedaling one (1) or more persons seated on one (1) or more saddle seats on its frame.

Bicycle Lane means part of a roadway designated by official signs or markings for exclusive use by persons riding bicycles, electric bicycles, or electric motorized scooters.

Motor Vehicle means every vehicle which is self-propelled, including, but not limited to, "allterrain vehicles" (ATVs), "four wheelers", golf carts, cars and trucks, whether propelled by electricity, solar, gas or diesel engines or motors. Electric bicycles and Electric Motorized Scooters, as defined by the Arkansas Electric Bicycle Act and the Arkansas Electric Motorized Scooter Act, are not motor vehicles for purposes of this Chapter.

Motorcycle means every motor vehicle having a saddle for the use of the rider and designated to travel on not more than three (3) wheels in contact with the ground.

Pedestrian Pathway means a path separate from a roadway designated by official signs or markings for exclusive use by pedestrians, which are defined as persons afoot.

Shared Use Path means a path separate from a roadway designated by official signs or markings for exclusive use by bicyclists, electric bicycles, electric motorized scooters, and pedestrians.

Vehicle means every device in, upon or by which any person or property is, or may be, transported or drawn upon a street or highway. <u>The term vehicle does not mean bicycles</u>, <u>electric bicycles</u>, or electric motorized scooters.

8.56.02 - Operation.

Except as permitted by Section 8.56.03, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate, park, or leave standing any vehicle, motor vehicle or motorcycle upon property designated as a City Bicycle Lane, Pedestrian Pathway, or Shared Use Path. Electric bicycles and electric motorized scooters, as defined by Arkansas law, are exempt from this prohibition to the extent permitted by the Arkansas Electric Bicycle Act and the Arkansas Electric Motorized Scooter Act.; however, no electric bicycle or electric motorized scooter shall be operated on a Pedestrian Pathway or Shared Use Path at a speed greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour.

8.56.03 - Exceptions.

A. Person(s) utilizing a wheelchair due to a physical handicap, whether motorized or not.

B. Any emergency vehicle and personnel while acting within the scope of their duties.

C. Any vehicle owned, leased or maintained by the City of Conway, and duly authorized personnel, while acting within the scope of their duties.

D. Any vehicle owned, leased or maintained by any utility corporation, and duly authorized personnel, while acting within the scope of their duties.

E. A person operating a vehicle, motor vehicle, or motorcycle, may enter a Bicycle Lane, Pedestrian Pathway, or Shared Use Path, to enter or exit the roadway, enter or leave a parking space, or prepare for a turn, but only after yielding the right of way to all bicyclists or pedestrians lawfully within the lane, pathway, or path.

8.56.04 - Fine.

Any person, firm and/or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to that extent of the conflict.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 2022, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2022, AND PROVIDING THAT THE AMOUNTS STATED IN THE BUDGET DOCUMENT AS ADOPTED EXPENDITURES SHALL BECOME APPROPRIATED FOR THE VARIOUS FUNCTIONS AND ACTIVITIES SPECIFIED IN SAID BUDGET DOCUMENT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Conway has submitted to the City Council a budget for the fiscal year 2022;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. A Budget for the fiscal year 2022 for the City of Conway, Arkansas; providing a total appropriation for the following funds:
