AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CONWAY ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY MAP REFERENCED IN SECTIONS 201.1 AND 201.3 OF THE CONWAY ZONING CODE TO REZONE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 1803, 1809 & 1811 MEADOWLAKE ROAD, FROM R-1 TO R-2:

Whereas, in accordance Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-56-416 has adopted a Zoning Code and Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-56-423 provides for the amendment of such regulations; and

Whereas, Proper public notice was given, and the Conway Planning Commission held a duly authorized public hearing on **February 20**th, **2024**, and adopted the amendments.

1803 Meadowlake Road

Part of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, T6N, R14W, Faulkner County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said SE 1/4 SW 1/4 at a found nail in Meadow lake Road, being thee point of beginning; thence along the North line of said SE 1/4 SW 1/4, South 88 degrees 29 minutes 35 seconds East, 205.00 feet; thence leaving said North line, South 01 degrees 47 minutes 23 seconds, West, 332.29 feet (deeded 330 feet) to a found 3/8" rebar; thence North 87 degrees 41 minutes 01 seconds West, 204.72 feet (deeded 205 feet) to a found 1/2" pipe; thence North 01 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds East 329.36 feet (deeded 330 feet) to the point of beginning, containing 1.56 acres more or less.

<u>Staff recommendation</u>: Staff recommended approval of the rezoning as it is adjacent to R-2 property to the east and North Plaza Market, a mixed-use Planned Unit Development, to the north. Given the surrounding structures and zoning, this use is appropriate for this area. The request is consistent with the Comprehensive plan and infill and increased density are appropriate for this location as it will help Conway meet its housing needs in an area characterized by a mixed-use PUD, commercial, and both R-1 and R-2 zoning.

The Planning Commission reviewed the request at its regular meeting on February 20, 2024, and voted 10-0 that the request be forwarded to the City Council with a recommendation for approval.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL PORTABLE RADIOS IN PREPARATION FOR THE TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE AND FUTURE EMERGENCY NEEDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

Whereas, for preparation of the total solar eclipse event on April 8th, 2024, the City has determined there is a need for ten (10) additional portable radios to adequately service the City; and

Whereas, the radios will be provided by L3 Harris Technologies, Inc., a vendor; and

Whereas, the cost for the additional 10 radios will be \$29,085.19.
