## AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE ENITRE ALLEY RUNNING WEST TO EAST THROUGH BLOCK 16, SRYGLEY ADDITION, IN THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

**Whereas,** a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas on the 11<sup>th</sup> of January, 2022 requesting the City Council to vacate and abandon the 14-foot alley running west to east through the whole of Block 16, Srygley Addition, within the corporate limits of the City of Conway, Arkansas; and

Whereas, after due notice as required by law, the council has, at the time and place mentioned in the notice, heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question and has ascertained that the alley or the portion thereof, hereinbefore described, has heretofore been dedicated to the public use as an alley herein described; has not been actually used by the public generally for a period of at least five (5) years subsequent to the filing of the plat; that all the owners of the property abutting upon the portion of the alley to be vacated have filed with the council their written consent to the abandonment; and that public interest and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of this alley through Block 16, Srygley Addition.

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

**Section 1.** That City of Conway, Arkansas releases, vacates, and abandons its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and through Block 16, Srygley Addition designated as follows:

ALL OF THE 14' ALLEY LOCATED IN BLOCK 16 OF SRYGLEY'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF CONWAY, AS RECORDED IN BOOK A, PAGE 52, FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS, SAID 14' ALLEY DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCING AT A FOUND X-CUT AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 6, BLOCK 16, SRYGLEY ADD.; THENCE SOUTH 2°06'39" WEST, 125.00 FEET ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID LOT 6 TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 6; THENCE SOUTH 88°24'16" EAST, 297.36 FEET ALONG THE NORTH LINE SAID 14 FOOT ALLEY; THENCE SOUTH 2°14'28" WEST, 14.00 FEET; THENCE NORTH 88°24'16" WEST, 297.20 FEET ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID 14 FOOT ALLEY; THENCE NORTH 1°35'44" EAST, 14.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING. CONTAINING 4,162 SQUARE FEET OR 0.096 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS.

The applicant is seeking to rezone the property from A-1 to MF-2 and C-3. MF-2 zoning would allow multifamily development to a maximum density of 18 units per acre. This would yield a maximum of 71 units. C-3 zoning would allow a variety of uses including various retail uses. The likely highest intensity use would be a fueling station. At this time, the applicant has not officially stated any definitive intended use for the site, but office/retail and multi-family is a likely use.

<u>Staff recommendation</u>: Staff recommends approval of the rezoning request as it is consistent with the established zoning precedent within this portion of Dave Ward Dr, would allow for appropriate use of the property in context to the surrounding area, and would not likely negatively impact adjacent properties.

The Planning Commission reviewed the request at its regular meeting on January 18, 2022 and voted 9-0 that the request be forwarded to the City Council with a recommendation for approval.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Conway owns property located at 811 North Creek Drive in the City of Conway, and upon which is situated the Faulkner County Health Department, which property is further described as follows:
