Because you failed or refused to remove, abate, or eliminate certain conditions on the aforementioned real property in the City of Conway, after having been given seven (7) days notice in writing to do so, the City of Conway was forced to undertake the cleanup of this property to bring it within compliance of the Conway Municipal Code.

The City of Conway is requesting payment for all costs expended in correcting said condition. If after thirty (30) days from the receipt of this letter notifying you of the cost to correct said condition, such payment has not been remitted to the City, the City has the authority to file a lien against real estate property for the cost expended after City Council approval.

At its **March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Meeting**, 6:30 p.m. located at 1111 Main Street, the City Council will conduct a public hearing on three items:

- 1. Consideration of the cost of the clean-up of your real property.

- 3. Consideration of certifying this amount determined at the hearing, plus a ten percent (10%) penalty for collection & filing fees, to the Tax Collector of Faulkner County to be placed on the tax books as delinquent taxes and collected accordingly.

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE OAK STREET CORRIDOR PLAN, AS AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2021, City Council passed Resolution R-21-78 authorizing professional engineering services with Garver Engineers, Inc. for the Oak Street Corridor Study and for other purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** the Oak Street Ahead Master Plan Document, Illustrative Plan, Transportation Framework and Regulating Plan were developed with extensive input from citizens, the Planning Commission, City Council members, staff, and numerous other stakeholders; and

WHEREAS, the City of Conway formed a steering committee in February 2022 including members of the Chamber of Commerce, local owners and representatives, developers, University of Central Arkansas (UCA) administration, Conway Corporation, Planning Commissioners, and City Council members to provide direction, course correction, and review of study deliverables; and

**WHEREAS,** the Planning Commission on March 13, 2023 voted unanimously to forward the plan to City Council with a recommendation of approval.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

**Section 1**. That the City Council of the City of Conway, Arkansas, hereby approves and recommends implementation as recommended within the Oak Street Ahead Regulating Plan.

**Section 2**. The Oak Street Ahead Plan is hereby adopted and shall be enforced through the Conway Comprehensive Plan and other regulations of the City of Conway, Arkansas.

#### MEMO - RE: OAK STREET AHEAD

To: Mayor, Council Members

On March 13<sup>th</sup>, the Oak Street Ahead project was brought by staff to the Planning Commission with a recommendation to forward to the City Council. The Planning Commission forwarded the plan to City Council with a unanimous recommendation of approval, to be heard at the March 28<sup>th</sup> meeting. The Oak Street Ahead plan has been extensively vetted by Planning Commission, Council Members, staff, and numerous stakeholders. This includes the steering committee which was formed in February of 2022 including the Chamber, local owners and representatives, developers, the University of Central Arkansas administration, Conway Corporation, Planning Commissioners, and City Council Members.

Westley Sullins, has requested to allow *Extermination Service* in the O-1 zoning district for property located at 783 Diane Lane, with the legal description:

A PART OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 15, T5N, R14W, FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS, DESCRIBED AS BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SOUTHWEST 1/4 NW 1/4, AND RUN THENCE NORTH 300 FEET; THENCE NORTH 89 DEGREES 28 MINUTES EAST 659.9 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 0 DEGREES 01 MINUTES EAST 300 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 89 DEGREES 28 MINUTES WEST 660 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

The applicant is requesting to open an exterminating service. The Comprehensive Plan designates this area as a Transition Zone. The Transition Zone allows for more intense uses only when sensitivity to adjoining residential areas is considered. This type of use is appropriate for this area. The site is situated at the corner of Dave Ward Dr and should not negatively impact adjacent parcels to the north or east. The size of the lot should allow for adequate space for operations and equipment.

<u>Staff recommendation</u>: Staff recommends approval of the conditional use permit, with the following 8 conditions:

- 1. Operating hours are limited to Monday Friday, 8:00am 5:00pm.
- 2. Any site improvements shall be subject to development standards as outlined in Article 10 of the Conway Zoning Code, unless otherwise noted in permit conditions.
- 3. Parking area must be striped and ADA requirements for parking must be met.
- 4. Tree plantings required along Dave Ward Dr and Diane Ln. A landscape plan must be submitted to Planning Staff for approval.
- 5. All signage shall be permitted and installed in accordance with Article 12 of the Conway Zoning Code (Sign Ordinance).
- 6. No zoning variance shall be issued as a result of the commencement of the conditional use.
- 7. Upon conditional use approval, any expansions or additions to the structures as well as any changes to the use shall require an amended or new conditional use permit.
- 8. The conditional use shall automatically expire if the approved use ceases for more than 18 consecutive months.

The Planning Commission reviewed the request at its regular meeting on March 13, 2023 and voted 7-0 that the request be forwarded to the City Council with a recommendation for approval.

Re: Request to rezone property located 4106 Prince Street, from R-1 to C-3

Josh Ferguson, has requested to rezone property located at 4106 Prince Street, from R-1 to C-3, with the legal description:

LOT 93, MALLARD CROSSING SUBDIVISION, FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS. LESS AND EXCEPT: THE NORTH 119 FEET THEREOF.

The applicant is seeking the rezoning from R-1 to C-3 as the result of a proposed remodel of the structure on the adjacent parcel at 4106 Prince St which required site development review. It was discovered during this review that the zoning of this small parcel had not been amended to align with the longestablished use. The property has been zoned C-3 since it was annexed in 1988 and been used as a storage area in support of the commercial use at 4106 Prince St since approximately 2007. The applicant is not proposing any expansion of the commercial use [at 4106 Prince St], beyond the existing fenced area, on this portion of the property at this time. While the zoning change is not consistent with the Comprehensive Plan the subject property has held in common ownership with 4106 Prince St since 1994. Approving the request will not likely negatively impact adjacent property and will resolve the nonconforming nature of the established use.

Staff recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the request as it will allow appropriate use of the property by resolving the non-conforming nature of the established use.

The Planning Commission reviewed the request at its regular meeting on October 17, 2022 and voted to table 8-0 that the request be tabled. The applicant requested to withdraw this agenda item on November 15, 2022 via email and is now requesting it be heard again.

Re: Appeal of the Director's Interpretation of Subdivision Ordinance (#0-00-03 as amended)

2805-2830 HARBELLE DR, CRESTHAVEN SUBDIVISION PHASE 4.

The applicant is appealing the interpretation and application of the Subdivision Regulations (#O-00-03 as amended), specifically Article V §9 that applies to the requirement for sidewalks, by the Director of Planning & Development, James Walden. The Planning Commission voted to forward the item to City Council for further review with concerns related to inconsistent application of the Subdivision Code. The Planning Commission's considerations were limited to determination as to if the Director did or did not interpret Section 9 of the Subdivision Code correctly, which states, "Sidewalks shall be constructed within any subdivision in accordance with these regulations", and Section 9.10.G which states, "If a waiver is granted, the subdivider/developer shall contribute funds in lieu of sidewalk construction equal to the four-year rolling average of the "WEIGHTED AVERAGE" amounts listed for "CONCRETE WALKS" in the four most recent editions of the "Arkansas Department of Transportation Weighted Average Unit Prices". This in-lieu fee shall be subject to a maximum fee equivalent to one hundred fifty (150) feet of street frontage per lot for lots intended for singlefamily or two-family dwelling uses. There shall no [sic] maximum fee for lots containing or intended for other uses." The Planning Commission did not have the ability to waive the requirement in full, which would require further actions by City Council to consider.

Staff recommendation: Staff does not typically provide recommendations for appeals, as the original recommendation is staff's interpretation of the Code. However, upon hiring a new Director of Planning & Development, the new Director can provide a recommendation. Staff was limited in recommendations to the Planning Commission, as it was a direct question to determine if the previous Director did or did not interpret the code correctly. However, the City Council can exercise their authority and consider additional options which will be presented by the Director. The current Director of Planning & Development will recommend the City Council to consider waiving the fees for 5 lots that are under contract, which will be Option 2 in the presentation.

The Planning Commission reviewed the original request at its regular meeting on March 13, 2023 and voted to forward the item to City Council for further consideration. The Director has added options that the City Council may consider which the Planning Commission did not have the authority to grant with the appeal.
