Because you failed or refused to remove, abate, or eliminate certain conditions on the aforementioned real property in the City of Conway, after having been given seven (7) days notice in writing to do so, the City of Conway was forced to undertake the cleanup of this property to bring it within compliance of the Conway Municipal Code.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDING AND ACCEPTING THE LOW BID FOR THE REMODEL OF 1116 GUM STREET FOR THE OVERNIGHT EMERGENCY SHELTER; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES;

Whereas, the Community Development Department solicited bids for the remodel of an office building located at 1116 Gum Street for the Overnight Emergency Shelter; and

Whereas, three bids were submitted for the remodel project; and

Whereas, BMD Builders submitted the low proposal for the project in the amount of \$1,805,000.00; and

Whereas, this project will be partially funded from the Community Development Block Grant Program Year funding and City funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. The City of Conway shall accept the bid from BMD Builders in the amount of \$1,805,00.00 for the Overnight Emergency Shelter Remodel Project.

Section 2: The City of Conway shall appropriate an amount not to exceed \$700,000 from the General Fund Balance Appropriation Account (001.119.4900) to Administration Misc. Account for the Overnight Emergency Shelter.

Section 3. All ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 4. This ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety; an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Bids were initially solicited for the Overnight Emergency Shelter on August 11, 2021. At that time the lowest bid came in at \$1,900,000.00, due to the rising construction cost we decided to hold the project for approximately 6 months to see if construction cost would go down. We solicited bids for the Overnight Emergency Shelter a second time, March 1, 2022, with the lowest bid at \$1,805,000.00, which came in approximately \$100,000 less than the previous year. Funding for this project total budget is \$1,800,00.00. Funding for this project will be \$1,200,000 from CDBG (CARES Act Funding, and Program year 2021 & 2022 funding). The CDBG program has already spent over \$260,000 on purchase of property, architects, testing, survey, etc.

We are requesting \$700,000 to complete this project.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY TO ACT PURSUANT TO ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §18-15-201 *ET SEQ.*, AND OTHER STATE STATUTORY AUTHORITY TO SEEK CONDEMNATION BY EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES DESCRIBED HEREIN FOR THE PUBLIC PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND MAINTAINING STREET, ROAD, SIDEWALK AND BOULEVARD RIGHT OF WAY AND ALL NECESSARY AND PROPER EASEMENTS RELATED THERETO FOR THE CITY OF CONWAY'S DONAGHEY PHASE II IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Conway, Arkansas, is a city of the First Class duly organized and existing as a municipal corporation under the laws of the State of Arkansas. The City of Conway ("the City") has its principal place of business within the borders of Faulkner County, Arkansas. Under Arkansas law, the City is empowered under Arkansas Code Annotated § 18-15-201, *et seq.*, and other statutory authority to condemn real property by eminent domain for the purposes of streets, parks, boulevards, and public buildings (among other lawful purposes); and

WHEREAS, as part of the planning, construction and maintenance of Donaghey Phase II ("the Project"), the City is in the process of planning and developing sufficiently wide and safe roads, streets, boulevards, sidewalks, and necessary and proper rights of way within the statutory areas relative to the corporate limits of Conway as set out in A.C.A. § 18-15-201(a)(2), the City Council for the City of Conway has found and determined that it is necessary for public purposes to acquire the real properties described herein upon which to construct and maintain said roadway, street and sidewalks. It is now necessary for public purposes to acquire the real properties, it is empowered under ACA §18-15-201 to seek condemnation through eminent domain of the properties as described herein and to properly compensate the owners of said lands pursuant to state law.

WHEREAS, to secure timely access to said real properties, however, it is necessary that eminent domain authority be declared, established, and exercised for the purpose of the construction, maintenance, and public use of the improved roadway, streets, boulevards, utilities, rights of way, sidewalks and appropriate appurtenances developed thereto. As well and on behalf of the public, the City must continue ownership and control of the real property described herein, as necessary for the public purposes of continued maintenance, traffic control, safety, drainage, pedestrian passage and necessary and proper services throughout the affected areas and properties described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: The City Council for the City of Conway hereby finds and determines that it is necessary for public purposes to acquire the real properties owned by certain landowner described herein upon which to construct and maintain said roadway, streets, boulevards, sidewalks and necessary easements. It is necessary for public purposes to acquire the real properties owned by the landowner described herein upon which to construct and maintain said roadway, streets, boulevards, sidewalks and necessary easements. Because the City has established a legitimate public purpose for said properties, the City is empowered under Ark. Code Ann. §18-15-201 to seek condemnation through eminent domain of the properties described herein and to properly compensate the owners of said lands pursuant to state law.

SECTION 2: Joshua and Jessica Rutherford are the individuals who own real estate upon and along

the Project area which is needed for the Project. The street address of the property is 2035 Prince, Conway, Arkansas 72034, with the real estate in question more particularly described below:

RIGHT OF WAY DESCRIPTION A part of lot 2, Block 44 of Robinson's Plan, City of Conway, Faulkner County, Arkansas, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING as the Northwest corner of said Lot 2; thence South 88°20'51" East along the North line of said Lot 2 a distance of 150.10 feet; thence South 86°39'09" West a distance of 77.69 feet to a point of curve; thence on a curve to the left 123.06 feet, having radius of 80 feet and a chord bearing South 45°56'92" West a distance 111.28 feet to the West line of said Lot 2; thence North 01°52'04" East along the West line of said Lot 2 a distance of 86.17 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.05 acres (2,093 sq. ft.) more or less.

SECTION 3: The City is further in need of Temporary Construction Easements for the Project, as more particularly described above, from the landowners as identified and detailed above.

SECTION 4: To secure timely access to said real properties, it is necessary that eminent domain authority be declared, established, and exercised for the purpose of the construction, maintenance, and public use of the improved roadway, streets, boulevards, sidewalks, rights of way, necessary and proper easements and appropriate appurtenances developed thereto. As well and on behalf of the public, the City must continue ownership and control of the real property described herein, as necessary for the public purposes of continued maintenance, traffic control, safety and necessary and proper rights of way and easements throughout the affected areas and properties described herein.

SECTION 5: The Office of the City Attorney of the City is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City and initiate statutory proceedings for eminent domain and condemnation of the lands described herein for the purposes stated herein, up to and including filing appropriate legal pleadings and process in those courts of law having jurisdiction over such process and proceedings.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CERTAIN LEASE AGREEMENTS WITH CONWAY CORPORATION FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 800 AND 850 SOUTH HARKRIDER STREET, AND 695 ENTERPRISE AVENUE FOR THE CONWAY TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, AS BEING NECESSARY FOR AND BENEFICIAL TO THE WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF CONWAY.

Whereas, The City Council previously authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Conway Corporation to purchase the Conway Corporation Service Center property for the City to use for the City Transportation Department; and

Whereas, Conway Corporation presently operates its service center at that location and is in the process of relocating its operations to another location in order to better serve the citizens of Conway; and

Whereas, until such time as Conway Corporation's new service center is ready to be occupied and used, various sections of the current service center will be used by the City for construction of a new fire station and for use by the Department of Transportation, and written leases for such sections will memorialize the terms of such use in the interim; and

Whereas, the cost for the property will be as follows: 740 S. Harkrider Street for \$413,000, 695 Enterprise Avenue for \$280,000, and 800 Harkrider Street for \$4,550,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: The City Council for the City of Conway hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into lease agreements with Conway Corporation for the lease and use of various sections of the Conway Corporation service center on South Harkrider street and Enterprise Avenue.

Section 2: The City shall appropriate \$5,248,000 (Including half of closing cost) from the Transportation Fund Balance Account – 002.201.4900 to the Transportation Building Acquisition 002.201.5903
