## **Resolution Passed**

- R-25-38 Resolution of a <u>voluntary</u> levy of <u>two-tenths (.2) mill</u> on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for an <u>Animal Shelter</u> for the City of Conway. **Vote 7-0**
- R-25-39 Resolution of a <u>voluntary</u> levy of <u>four-tenths (.4) mill</u> on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for a recreation assessment raising special revenue for the sole and exclusive purpose of providing additional funds for the purpose of construction, equipping, operating, and maintaining the *public recreation and playgrounds* of City of Conway. *Vote 7-0*
- R-25-40 Resolution of a <u>voluntary</u> levy of <u>four-tenths (.4) mil</u>l on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue the exclusive purpose of operating, and maintaining the <u>cemeteries</u> for the City of Conway. **Vote 7-0**
- R-25-41 Resolution of a levy of <u>four-tenths (.4) mill</u> on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue for the Pension and Relief Fund for a <u>Policeman's Pension and Relief Fund</u>. Vote 7-0
- R-25-42 Resolution of a levy of <u>four-tenths (.4) mill</u> on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue for the Pension and Relief Fund for a <u>Fireman's</u> <u>Pension and Relief Fund</u>. Vote 7-0
- R-25-43 Resolution of a levy of <u>four-tenths (.4) mill</u> on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising special revenue for the Pension and Relief Fund for paid <u>Non-uniformed employees</u>. Vote 7-0
- R-25-44 Resolution of a levy of <u>three (3.0) mill</u> on the dollar be made upon the assessed valuation of all taxable real estate and personal property tax for raising <u>General Fund Revenues</u>. Vote 7-0
