# **September Minute Approval**

### **Updates**

- \* Discussion about advertising it at Arbor Day
- \* Will be led by Ecology Professor & Plant Physiologist

# No Mow May Discussion

- \* Potential idea pitched to consider a "No Mow May" to help pollinators.
- \* The city would need to ensure code enforcement doesn't penalize residents during May.

## **Arbor Day Event**

- \* Free tree giveaways occur in the fall for Arbor Day, with reservations taken in advance for larger trees.
- \* Google Forms have been used to collect reservations, including species selection.
- \* In the past, Tree Board monitored responses and manually removed options as they were claimed.
- \* Shopify could be used for the free tree giveaways to simplify process
- \* Shopify Trial is free for 3 days, then \$3 for 3 months. Motion to spend \$3 for the website for three months was made (Skylor) and seconded (Little); motion passed
- \* Need to vote on allocating \$200 for the drums; Motion made (Little) and seconded (Bell); motion passed
- \* Ellen Smith: Have not heard back regarding choir
- \* Caitlin Riles: Bell contacted regarding wampus cat mascot & waiting for response
- \* Secret Nook gave two \$20 or \$25 gift cards for the poetry contest prizes.
- \* CBC will be doing pine cone decorating station; may need to collect more pine cones for this event
- \* UCA Water Table is available
- \* Krista reached out to beekeepers, but they haven't responded
- \* Master Gardeners will be there and needs several tables
- \* Suggestion to plant donated tree near the persimmon champion tree

#### **Tree Giveaway**

- \* Last year Parks picked up the trees from Bemis
- \* Need to ask if they can do that again on the Friday before.

- \* Sanitation Dept also confirmed

#### **Poe-Tree Contest**

- \* Mr. Campbell (middle school teacher), Ms. Sweer (literacy specialist), and Adriana Davis (author) are confirmed judges.
- \* Google Forms submissions end on Oct 24th.
- \* Board members may need to vote on submissions if there are too many.
- \* Ideally, judges will access the Google Form and vote there.
- \* There will be youth and adult categories.
- \* Gift cards from Secret Nook (first place) and Soapbox Laundry will be used for prizes.
